

IT'S NOT EASY BEING THE BOSS

FOCAL PASSAGE: Genesis 6:9 & 6:12-14

BIBLICAL TRUTH: God wants us to do things that are not always the most popular thing to do.

BUSINESS IMPACT: Doing God's will ends in blessings for those who are found righteous.

Genesis 6:9 & 6:12-14 *Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God. 12. God saw how corrupt the earth had become, for all the people on earth had corrupted their ways. 13. So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth. 14. So make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out".*

Can you imagine what the people of his time must have thought of Noah, building a boat in the middle of the desert?

When you're the boss so many times you have to do things that just don't make sense to everybody else and it's not an easy place to be. You may become known for being crazy, mean or set in your own ways etc.

But just like Noah you may be privileged to information that others may not receive and to do the will of God may sometimes make us look a little crazy, remember Jericho?
