

TRUST THE PEOPLE YOU PUT IN CHARGE

FOCAL PASSAGE: EXODUS 18:17-19

BIBLICAL TRUTH: You have to learn how to delegate some of the workload and trust those you put in charge.

BUSINESS IMPACT: by sharing workloads one person can go a lot further and the company can be more productive.

Exodus 18:17-19 *Moses' father-in-law replied, "What you are doing is not good. 18. You and these people who come to you will only wear yourselves out. The work is too heavy for you; you cannot handle it alone. 19. Listen now to me and I will give you some advice, and may God be with you. You must be the people's representative before God and bring their disputes to him.*

Sometimes the hardest thing to change after a promotion is you.

But with this attitude you increase your labor and reduce the effectiveness of the business and the product.
